WorkCover Authority NSW Approval First Aid 9323
- Target Group:** All organisations, industries and workplaces using remote or outdoor environments and where longer ambulance response times may be encountered
- Valid:** 3 years
- Pre-requisite:** Full course — Nil  
Extension course - participants must hold a current approved first aid certificate
